Regular Town Board Meeting

October 11, 2022

Lewis Town Hall

Present: Counselors Lanita Canavan, Terry Pulsifer, John Blades, Steven Denton, Supervisor James Monty, Highway Superintendent Kevin Denton and Codes Officer Les Howard.

Called to Order: The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Monty at 7 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance

Guests: Scott Belcastro, Trebel LLC, Energy Services

Kaylie, from Imerys Site/NYCO Minerals, stated they were approved for a Permit amendment by the APA which was recorded with the County. They had a production increase at the mine and to keep up with the production they will need a lot more stripping. They received a temporary approval to do stripping, on site only, Saturdays from 8 AM to 2 PM and were approved for over road hauling Monday through Fridays until the end of the year.

Supervisor's Financial Report: A motion was made to accept the Supervisor's Financial Report by Lanita Canavan and seconded by Terry Pulsifer, 0 opposed, motion carried.

- 1. **Budget Transfer** Supervisor Monty requested 4 budget transfers:
 - \$3,040.61- To cover increased fuel costs. This transfer will be every month from now until the end of the year due to exceeding the fuel line.
 - \$397.99 To cover the cost of lids for additional meter pits.
 - \$260.00 To cover the cost of NYRWA Dues.
 - \$20.44 To cover the costs depletion by water leak repair.

A motion was made to accept the Budget Transfer by Lanita Canavan and seconded by John Blades, 0 opposed, motion carried.

Public Commentary: Jeff Scott is concerned about the insulation in the Town Hall and the repair to the foundation stating it will benefit the Town. Jeff stated a plan should be put forward for repairs using the capital reserve fund money.

Jeff read from the close out meeting board minutes from last December 2021. He's hoping the Board will take into consideration to move forward with these repairs. The Board does not disagree that these repairs need to be done and will take it into consideration. Jeff offered to be a public liaison volunteer to meet with the building maintenance people on the Board once every 3 months.

DPW/Water Report: Kevin Denton stated they have the winter sand up. The Roscoe culvert project has been put on hold until spring. They temporarily put in 6 foot culverts until next spring. Kevin stated they received their new one-ton truck and would like to put the other truck up for surplus. A motion was made to declare it surplus by Steve Denton and seconded by Lanita Canavan, 0 opposed, motion carried.
