- 3. Town Hall Rehabilitation Plan Jeff Scott stated the Town Hall needs foundation work and that there is money in the Capitol Reserve Fund that can be used for the repairs. Supervisor Monty stated a Request for Proposals is needed to tell the Board what needs to be done, as the project would have to go out to bid.
